

R & D support to the rubber industry is provided by the Rubber Research Institute of Malaysia (RRIM), the Rubber Technology Centre (RTC), and the Tun Abdul Razak Research Centre (TARRC) in the U.K.

With strong support from these and other government and private sector institutions, Malaysian manufacturers have developed the capacity to produce a wide array of automotive parts, ranging from simple products such as car mats, weather strips, various types of hoses, dust covers, boots and bellows, and mud flaps to complex components such as bushes, seals, gaskets, vibration mountings and various rubber-to-metal bonded parts.
